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Introduction

The Design

Showmanager has been designed to incorporate the expertise and know-how from experienced equestrian centre owners, riders and event judges. The modular design of the software components and the modern architecture facilitates them, working with your existing systems, websites and infrastructure. **Showmanager** is designed to manage all aspects of the event or Show as a "**JOINED-UP**" solution, that will save you time and money and help you deliver well-run events that are appreciated by everyone.

The Benefits

Whether using individual tools and systems, or simply writing everything down on paper, if the information is not integrated or shared across the Competition centre, then someone, somewhere has to link each of the tasks and bits of information together, **This means extra time and cost!** Most Equestrian Competition centres today have a lot of different technology and software that they can use including:

- 1. Electronic Wireless timing systems
- 2. Invoicing applications and spreadsheets
- 3. Judging applications
- 4. Radio walkie-talkies
- 5. Online entries
- 6. Video streaming to TVs and websites
- 7. Membership databases
- 8. Customer Lists
- 9. Commentators Databases and information
- 10. Point of Sales (POS) terminals where payments are taken



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The challenge is that these tend to be standalone or "silo" technologies that are seldom, if ever, integrated and do not talk to each other. They have access to, use and store lots of information, and while individually they do their own single set of tasks extremely well, they are not "JOINED-UP", and the information cannot ne re-used.

The information can only be shared by additional human interaction and effort, which is time consuming, clumsy and expensive. At best this can result in just extra costs and extra manpower required to run the show; and at worst it can be the difference between a show running smoothly or delays and interruptions, that materially can impact the overall efficiency of the Competition centre, and the competitors enjoyment.

Poorly run shows inevitably mean that the subsequent shows are not as well supported because nobody wants to have to wait around all the time not knowing what is going on, and everyone wants to compete where the shows are run efficiently, and on-time. Everyone!, Organisers, Competitors, Owners and Spectators needs to know what is going on and what will happen next.....they want to be properly informed.

Showmanager creates these "**JOINED-UP**" systems and software, where information collected at each stage is shared across a common database so it can be re-used where needed, and displayed to keep people regularly updated with the shows progress.

Showmanager was designed from its inception to do this task and link together all the disparate systems so that information flows across the show and in the arenas.

How it Works

All that is required to access the software is a standard computer, PC/laptop or tablet with connection to the Internet. You don't need to worry about anything, just fire up your PC and Login. All the processing technology, hardware and software for **showmanager** reside off-site in a secure "Cloud" Datacentre accessed via the Internet.

The software has been developed so that it is compatible with most other common software systems and information such as Schedules, Results and Membership details which can be shared, displayed, exported/imported and simply integrated with your website.





- · Prize money and timing





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2. Class Entry Application

Class entry allows for both on-line registration of the riders and horses into Event Classes and the manual entry and overriding control of the same details by the organiser's admin staff. **Showmanger** links in to all of the different Databases that are used on-site (the Organiser's Customer lists) so that for all events, the Horse/Rider/Owner details are already present and recognised immediately. The software supports the normal payment gateways such as PayPal, Sage, Worldpay, Stripe etc. as well as payments by cheque or cash on the day of the event.



As soon as the Competitor is entered in to the class, the software looks up the Class entry fee and automatically adds that on to the account of the competitor ensuring all entries are properly accounted for. The Competitors (Horse and Rider) are automatically added on to the start list for each class and appear in the Collecting Ring sub-system ready to be declared. Competitors can be simply and quickly moved in and out of the classes they require on demand and the Competitors account is instantly update as appropriate.

3. Website Integration Application

showmanager can be completely integrated into your existing website to provide on-line self-service registration against specific classes on specific show days. Riders can register and pay on-line, and the information is then dynamically entered into the Showmanager

database which removes multiple entry of the same data. Accounts can be set up and managed for entry fees as well as all other on-site expenses associated with the show. The website can have live feeds of each class as it happens on show days,






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so competitors can see all of the relevant details about class numbers, estimated class start times and potential delays, as well as the latest results.



4. Onsite Judging & Collecting Ring Applications


Show Jumping, Dressage and Cross Country/Arena Eventing all have different Judging mechanisms and elements of these can be automated. Show Jumping is the simplest of these to automate and **showmanager** offers a comprehensive Judging sub-system that is integrated in to the heart of the system so that Entries, Horse and Rider, faults, times, Class conditions and rules are all provided in a simple format for the Judges to effectively manage each class to a conclusion.





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A Collecting Ring sub-system provides multiple links to the warm up areas. The collecting ring system allows a declarations list to be compiled from the warm up area which then transfers to the judging system under 'jumping order'. The collecting ring system allows the steward to view a full start list for each class, and to enable a competitor's entry number to be looked up if they don't know it! From the same screen the competitor's entries can be clearly seen and declared or withdrawn as appropriate, or moved to another slot.



The Complete Judging subsystem can be linked to the Dark Deer Timing systems and displays so that the timing data is automatically fed into the judging module. It can also be linked to larger displays which as well as showing the time, can display the horse and rider's name, as well as additional information on the current class Results, positions and "time to beat".



The same information can similarly be displayed on restaurant screens (monitors) and other displays in Public areas as required.







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5. Membership & Marketing Applications

Some Equestrian Show centres offer membership systems, which allow the participants to accrue benefits. These may be reduced entry fees, special shows, shopping discounts or alternative vouchers of similar value. Not everyone who has an account or rides at an arena has to be a member but from the organisers point of view, offering membership allows them to keep in closer contact with the riders by email, letter, SMS text etc. to make them aware of special offers and forthcoming events. **showmanger** allows Equestrian centres to create a Membership database entry, as competitors register for individual Events and classes, which can be used for marketing and benefit recognition. Similarly discounts for entries can be applied dynamically without any manual intervention saving time and improving the service.







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6. Financial Reporting & Management


Part of the Management for any Show is the ability to be able to manage the finances to ensure that every entry, and additional products and services (stables, hook-ups etc) purchased, and Prize money won is effectively accounted for.

Showmanager can provide a ledger or an account for each client or Business so that the Equestrian Centre can provide a detailed bill or invoice detailing all the costs incurred, payments made and credits won from Prize money. In addition, the system can produce a statement for a client between any two dates allowing the customer to see the makeup of their current balance.

There is a Point of Sale (POS) screen where you just quickly want to take the money and record payments and refunds, which can be integrated with a cash drawer and cash-reconciliation report.

The software also provides complete reports on all the Shows activities, revenues costs and profit and can export these to Microsoft Excel for further processing or integration in to Accounting systems, or similar software.





The Reports include a full Profit and Loss analysis for each Event including:

- Prize money
- Other Income
 - Stables
 - Haylage
 - o Hook ups
 - o First Aid
- Outstanding Accounts
 - Creditors
 - Debtors
- Income by Class
- Expenses




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
7. Mobile Telephones and SMART Applications

showmanager can share all of the information on the show status, competitor and horse details, results and entry information on a personalised application that can be downloaded by your clients spectators and riders. The software is available for all types of SMART phones. Integration in to the main database allows the software to provide a number of notifications and dynamic text updates to the phone including:

- Proactive alerts to make competitors aware
- General updates on the Event's progress
- Class results as they unravel
- Rider alerts when they are due to ride
- Event updates on timing and class

Showmanager provides access to a display portal, which is optimised for mobile phones so that Organisers, Riders and Spectators can access the latest information about the show:





This includes look-ups for their bridle/entry numbers, Class status, Live Judging, Drawn Orders and a Results archive.


